# WHERE TO USE

Barrettine Shed & Fence is ideal for use over rough cut timber such as that used in sheds. fences, trellis etc. Provides an opaque matt/satin finish but allows the texture or wood to show through. If used on smooth planed timber, the resulting colour may be paler than if applied to rough sawn timbers. It is therefore recommended that at least 2 coats are applied for best results. Barrettine Shed & Fence is harmless to plants and pets when dry and can safely be used around the garden.

# COVERAGE

Normally one coat cover, unless large colour difference. (Between wood or previous coating). **Coverage:** Up to 6sq meters per litre.

Note: The final dried colour wood shade will depend on the age, colour, absorbency and condition of the wood, also whether a previous treatment has been applied. Carry out a small test area first Colours may vary slightly from batch to batch – if using more than one container mix before use to ensure uniformity.

# DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Illustrated colours may be intermixed to give a colour of choice. Ensure sufficient amount is mixed to complete the project. Do not use in damp or humid conditions, or if rain is imminent. Do not use in temperatures of below  $5^{\circ}$  ( $41^{\circ}F$ )

## PREPARATION

- All wood to be coated must be dry and clean, remove any mould, lichen, algae etc with decking and patio cleaner.
- Ensure previous coatings or repellents have been removed or are sufficiently weathered to allow treatment to penetrate/bond to the surface.

### APPLICATION

- Remove lid carefully. STIR WELL BEFORE USE.
- Apply with a conventional paint brush or deep piled roller evenly over the surface.
- Allow to dry thoroughly before applying a second coat.

# PRECAUTIONS

- Transport only in an upright position ensuring the lid/ container is firmly secured.
- Not recommended for use on timbers in permanent contact with the ground.
- Not suitable for use on Garden Furniture.
- Protect from frost. Store at temperatures above 5°C.
- Avoid splashes on leaves or flowers – any splashes should be washed with plenty of water before dry.
- Colour in the container may be different to the dry shade. Test an area first.
